JUSTICE ANNE BURKE ANNOUNCES VACANCY IN SEVENTH SUBCIRCUIT OF COOK COUNTY

Illinois Supreme Court Justice Anne M. Burke has begun an application process for a judicial vacancy in the Seventh Subcircuit of Cook County.

The vacancy was created by the retirement of Circuit Judge Marianne Jackson. Judge Jackson had served as a judge since 1997. Her resignation took effect December 31, 2018.

Under the Illinois Constitution, judicial vacancies are filled on an interim basis by Supreme Court appointment. Justice Burke will make a recommendation to the Supreme Court after applicants for the position undergo a screening and evaluation process.

The process will include a review by a special judicial screening committee that Justice Burke established in 2006. The Committee is chaired by Kevin M. Forde, Esq.

To be eligible for consideration for appointment, the applicant must be a lawyer in good standing, licensed to practice law in Illinois, and a resident of the Seventh Subcircuit.

The deadline for submission of applications is 4 p.m. on **Wednesday, March 6, 2019**.

Notice of the vacancy and details of the application process are posted on the Illinois Supreme Court's website at www.illinoiscourts.gov. From there, follow the instructions on the "Latest News" scroller announcing the Seventh Judicial Subcircuit of Cook County vacancy.

The person appointed to fill the vacancy will serve until December 6, 2020 when the position will be filled by the November 2020 General Election.

The Seventh Judicial Subcircuit encompasses all or portions of the following: the City of Chicago, Berwyn, Cicero, Proviso and River Forest, among others.
