

**ANNOUNCEMENT**

**September 29, 2005**

The Supreme Court of Illinois is accepting, through its Administrative Office, resumes from candidates seeking appointment to the Minimum Continuing Legal Education Board, as provided in Supreme Court Rule 792 of the Minimum Continuing Legal Education Rules (Supreme Court Rules 790 *et seq.*).

In accordance with the Rule, the Board shall consist of nine members, appointed by the Supreme Court, at least one of which shall be a nonattorney and at least one of which shall be a circuit court judge. The Rule further provides that an attorney candidate must have actively practiced law in Illinois for a minimum of 10 years to be eligible for service on the Board.

Candidates shall submit, along with their resume, a brief personal statement, limited to one page, mailed or hand-delivered to: Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts, Attn: Cynthia Y. Cobbs, Director, 222 N. LaSalle Street, 13<sup>th</sup> Floor, Chicago, Illinois 60601. All materials must be received by 5 p.m. on October 31, 2005.

No inquiries are to be directed to the Supreme Court. Upon completion of its review of the candidates, the Court shall announce the MCLE Board appointees.
