ORDER

In the exercise of the Court's general administrative and supervisory authority over all courts, and in response to the "Petition for an Extension of Time to Comply with Order 18368" submitted by the Clerk of the Circuit Court in Greene County and requesting an extension to mandatory civil e-filing until July 1, 2018;

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The request for extension of time for mandatory civil e-filing until July 1, 2018 is denied. The Circuit Clerk shall continue to accept e-filings through eFileIL and work with the case management system (CMS) vendor to expedite integration with eFileIL.
2. Given the Court's recent amendments to Supreme Court Rule 9 providing for self-represented litigants (SRLs) to receive a good cause exemption from e-filing, the court may accept traditional paper filings for SRL filers, consistent with Rule 9, while the courthouse kiosk computer issues are resolved.
3. The AOIC will facilitate technical or procedural assistance provided to the Clerk of the Circuit Court in Greene County and monitor the status of the CMS integration.
