ORDER

In the exercise of the Court's general administrative and supervisory authority over all courts, and in response to the "Petition for an Extension of Time to Comply with Order 18368" submitted by the Winnebago County Circuit Clerk requesting an extension to the mandate on e-filing for self-represented litigants until July 1, 2018 and an extension to migrate to eFileIL until July 1, 2019;

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Circuit Clerk's request for extension of time until July 1, 2018 to effectuate mandatory e-filing by self-represented litigants is granted.
2. The Circuit Clerk's request for extension of time until July 1, 2019, to migrate to eFileIL is denied. The Circuit Clerk shall continue to work with Tyler Technologies to migrate to eFileIL and "go-live" with permissive e-filing while still allowing sufficient time to test and train on eFileIL in advance of the July 1, 2018 mandate.
3. The AOIC will engage with the Circuit Clerk and Tyler Technologies throughout the eFileIL migration and report to the Court should a further extension be necessary.
