ORDER

In the exercise of the Court's general administrative and supervisory authority over all courts, and in response to the "Petition for Extension of Time to Comply with Order M.R. 18368" submitted by DuPage County requesting an extension to migrate to eFileIL until January 1, 2021;

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The DuPage County petition requesting an extension of time until January 1, 2021, to migrate to eFileIL is denied. In recognition of the level of integration and e-filing features currently implemented in DuPage County, an extension until July 1, 2019, is granted to migrate to eFileIL and make court documents and case information available to re:SearchIL.
2. The Circuit Clerk shall commit the necessary resources to migrate from the stand-alone e-filing system to eFileIL and "go-live" with permissive e-filing while allowing sufficient time to test and train on eFileIL in advance of the July 1, 2019 mandate.
3. The AOIC will engage with the Circuit Clerk and Tyler Technologies throughout this eFileIL migration and report on progress to the Court.
