



# Active Adult Cases


## End of Year Total 2004 - 2008

# Active Felony Cases


## End of Year Total 2004 - 2008

# Active Juvenile Cases


End of Year Total 2004 - 2008

## ABBREVIATIONS

Explanations for abbreviations used in column headings in this section are explained below.

Admin.	<u>Administrative Cases</u> : Cases still active but not under direct supervision.
PSI	<u>Presentence Investigation</u> : A comprehensive written background investigation report on a convicted offender prepared by the probation department to provide information to the court to determine an appropriate sentence.
Abbr. PSI	<u>Abbreviated Presentence Investigation</u> : Sometimes referred to as a "short form" presentence investigation, this is a less-comprehensive report permitted in less serious (i.e., misdemeanor) criminal cases.
TASC	<u>Treatment Alternatives for Special Clients</u> : A state-designated private agency licensed to provide substance abuse assessment, referral, and case monitoring services for criminal defendants/offenders with chemical dependency problems.
IPS	<u>Intensive Probation Supervision Program</u> : A highly structured, surveillance oriented, prison diversion program for non-violent felony offenders sentenced to probation.
MRAI	<u>Minors Requiring Authoritative Intervention</u> : Generally referred to as "status offenders" such as runaways, incorrigibles, etc.
CUS	<u>Continued Under Supervision</u>
