Definition Of Aggravated Discharge Of A Firearm--Discharge At A Person, Vehicle, Or Building

A person commits the offense of aggravated discharge of a firearm when he knowingly discharges a firearm

[1] in the direction of or into a building he knows to be occupied and from a place or position outside that building.

[or]

[2] in the direction of [(another person) (a vehicle he knows to be occupied)].
