Definition Of Indecent Solicitation Of A Child

A person of the age of 17 years or older commits the offense of indecent solicitation of a child when he [(solicits a child under the age of 13 years to do any act) (solicits a person to arrange an act with a child under the age of 13 years)] which if done would be [(aggravated criminal sexual assault) (predatory criminal sexual assault of a child) (criminal sexual assault) (aggravated criminal sexual abuse) (criminal sexual abuse)].
