M.R.24817 - In re: Jeffrey Michael Johns. Disciplinary Commission.

The petition by the Administrator of the Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission to impose reciprocal discipline pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 763 is allowed, and respondent Jeffrey Michael Johns, who has been disciplined in the State of Kansas, is suspended from the practice of law for two (2) years in the State of Illinois and until he is reinstated in the State of Kansas.

Suspension effective December 8, 2011.

Respondent Jeffrey Michael Johns shall reimburse the Client Protection Program Trust Fund for any Client Protection payments arising from his conduct prior to the termination of the period of suspension.
