### **CONFERENCE YEAR 2013**

#### *Statement of Purpose:*

The Committee on Strategic Planning shall provide consultation, guidance and recommendations regarding long-range planning for the Illinois courts.

#### *General Charge:*

The Committee will assist the Supreme Court in advancing its goal of an impartial, accessible and efficient justice system by identifying emerging trends and issues affecting the delivery of justice and developing specific objectives, and actions to address each trend and issue.
