CONFERENCE YEAR 2014

Statement of Purpose:

The Study Committee shall make recommendations, through proposed rules or other procedures, to reduce the cost and delay attendant to lengthy civil and criminal trials with multiple parties or issues. The Committee shall provide updates as necessary to its Manual for Complex Litigation (Civil and Criminal).

General Charge:

The Committee shall prepare revisions, updates, and new topics as necessary, for the Manual for Complex Litigation, including the maintenance of forms and links to forms provided throughout the Manual.

Conference Year 2014 Projects/Priorities:

- Complete the new edition of the Criminal Manual.
- Update the Civil Manual as necessary with any major changes in rules, statutes or cases.
- Coordinate with the Committee on Discovery Procedures to prepare for the consolidation of both committees in Conference Year 2015 into the Civil Justice Committee, including discussions regarding the membership and tasks for the new committee.
- Coordinate with the Criminal Justice Committee and the Committee on Education to determine the appropriate committee to house and revise the Complex Litigation Civil and Criminal Manuals.
- Undertake any such other projects or initiatives that are consistent with the Committee charge.
