MISCELLANEOUS RECORD

M.R.23874 - In re: Michael Jay Smith. Disciplinary Commission.

The petition by the Administrator of the Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission for reciprocal discipline pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 763 is allowed, and respondent Michael Jay Smith, who has been disciplined in the State of Indiana, is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Illinois for one (1) year and until he is reinstated to the practice of law in Indiana.

Suspension effective October 14, 2010.

Respondent Michael Jay Smith shall reimburse the Client Protection Program Trust Fund for any Client Protection payments arising from his conduct prior to the termination of the period of suspension.

Order entered by the Court.

M.R.23885 - In re: Sue E. Radulovich. Disciplinary Commission.

The petition by the Administrator of the Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission for reciprocal discipline pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 763 is allowed, and respondent Sue E. Radulovich, who has been disciplined in the State of Michigan, is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Illinois for one hundred twenty (120) days.

The request by respondent Sue E. Radulovich that discipline be imposed retroactively is denied.

The request by respondent Sue E. Radulovich that no costs be imposed is denied without prejudice to respond to any cost petition filed by the Administrator pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 773.

Suspension effective October 14, 2010.

Respondent Sue E. Radulovich shall reimburse the Client Protection Program Trust Fund for any Client Protection payments arising from her conduct prior to the termination of the period of suspension.
