In the exercise of the general administrative and supervisory authority over the courts of Illinois conferred on this Court pursuant to Article VI, Section 16 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 (Ill.Const.1970, art. VI, sect. 16);

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective September 1, 2020, the following orders are vacated:

- 1. The order of March 24, 2020 providing for the temporary extension of deadlines to file petitions for leave to appeal, appellant and appellee briefs, and petitions for rehearing in the Supreme Court and the directive to the appellate court to hold mandates for 70 days from the appellate court judgment;
- 2. The order of March 24, 2020 providing for the temporary extension of deadlines to file a notice of appeal in the circuit court and briefs (appellant and appellee) and petitions for rehearing in the appellate court; and
- 3. The order of April 2, 2020 suspending the paper copy requirement in the Supreme Court's Electronic Filing Procedures and User Manual.

Any deadline set, mandate being held, or paper copy requirement suspended in accordance with the above referenced orders prior to the effective date of this Order shall remain in effect.
